Final Report from the Joint Cancer Registry of the Federal States of East Germany

The Joint Cancer Registry (JCR) was founded in the 1950s and dissolved on 31 December 2022. It was a political decision to end the joint epidemiological registration and continue the cancer registration seperately in the five federal States former belonging to the JCR: Berlin/Brandenburg, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, Saxony-Anhalt, Saxony, and Thüringen. The JCR has completed a comprehensive final report before its dissolution, which is now available to preview and download.
