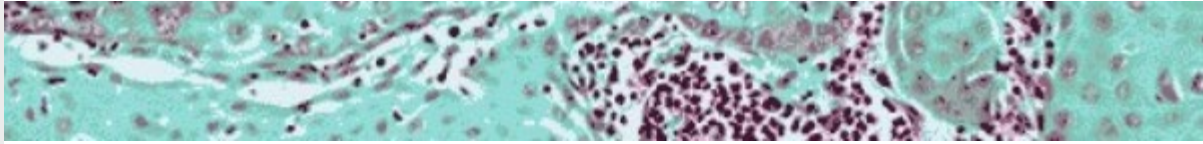

Publication in *Frontiers in Oncology*: Quality indicators: completeness, validity and timeliness of cancer registry data

contributing to the European Cancer Information System

The aim of the article is the evaluation of the quality of CRs data collected in the first ENCR-JRC data call (incidence period 1995-2014). The study is based on indicators evaluating completeness, validity and timeliness as data quality dimensions. Reported results are to be interpreted as the baseline for monitoring CRs data quality indicators in Europe along time.
