Date linkage and cancer registries

Guidelines for Abstract Submission for oral presentation or poster presentation at the ENCR Scientific Meeting

1. The abstract must be written in **English**.
2. The abstract title must be max **120 characters** (including spaces) and typed in UPPER case. Titles should be indicative of the content of the abstract. All words necessary to identify the subject matter should be included in the title to facilitate electronic retrieval. Avoid non-standard abbreviations in abstract titles.
3. Up to **10** authors can be included in the author list. Any additional authors will be replaced by "*et al.*". The list of contributors, from Working Groups, will be considered and displayed separately in dedicated pages.
4. The abstract body (not including title and authors) should contain no more than **2000 characters** (including spaces). Abbreviations may be used in the body if they are defined when first mentioned in the text. Do not include any tables, pictures, references, or conflict disclosures.
5. Please structure your abstract using the following sub-headings:
 - Background & Introduction;
 - Materials & Methods;
 - Results;
 - Conclusions.
6. Please check spelling and grammar carefully. It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract: as your submitted abstract text will be electronically reproduced, any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific data are likely to be published as submitted;
7. Abstracts can be submitted [through this link](#).
8. A scientific committee will review the abstracts and will send, **by 6 July 2018** at the latest, a notification of acceptance (specifying selection for oral or poster presentation) or rejection. Notifications of abstract receipt will be sent to the same e-mail address indicated in the abstract submission.
9. All accepted abstracts will be published in a book of abstracts which will be made available to participants at the meeting. This book will be published on the ENCR website before the meeting.

10. Those wishing to apply for JRC funding to support their attendance at the meeting must submit an abstract before applying for financial support.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DEADLINE: 25 May 2018
